1.	Please allow 30 minutes' preparation time to groom and tack your horse before your lesson and be ready to ride
	at the time your lesson is scheduled. If you start your lesson late, your lesson will be cut shortInitial
2.	If you are unable to attend your scheduled lesson, please notify your instructor at least 24 hours prior, otherwise
	you will be charged for the lesson (at BERA discretion). A NO SHOW CAN NOT BE MADE UP AND YOU ARE
	RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYMENT. A make-up lesson will be scheduled for a properly cancelled lesson.

3.	All lessons must be paid by the 5 th of the month to get the "Monthly Discount" rate, otherwise you will be
	charged on a "per lesson" basis. Lessons are paid at the beginning, not at the end, of the month. Lessons paid
